Shimizu Terminal Hosts Local Junior High School Students for On-site Learning Sessions

TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; representative: Jun Mutoh) welcomed three local junior high school students to its Shimizu terminal (Shimizu-ku, Shizuoka City; manager: Toshihiko Okamoto) for three days starting May 25 in cooperation with a workplace on-site learning program implemented by Shizuoka City to help junior high school students learn about society through direct observation of workplaces. The students participated in a variety of activities, including listening to explanations about the terminal, oil movement and shipment operations, and safety initiatives; looking at samples of gasoline and other oil products; and putting on safety harnesses. Most of these experiences, especially those such as the observation of a tank that had been opened for inspection and tank truck loading procedures, were new to the students, who expressed their impressions with comments such as, "This is my first time to observe a real workplace, and it's really eye-opening to see all these things I've never seen before. It's a great experience." The Shimizu terminal will continue its social contribution activities in accordance with its belief that the TonenGeneral Group's businesses are members of the communities in which they operate.
