Wakayama Refinery Participates in Jinoshima Volunteer Cleanup

The Wakayama refinery (Arida City, Wakayama; manager: Eiji Kato) of Tonengeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; representative: Jun Mutoh; “the Company” herein) participated in a volunteer cleanup on the island of Jinoshima on June 4 in cooperation with the Arida City Hall and the Arida City Sightseeing Association.

Jinoshima, an uninhabited island located in the Kii Channel about one kilometer from the Wakayama refinery, features beaches with clean, clear water, and is a popular swimming and camping spot in the summer months, when a ferry transports passengers between the island and the mainland.

A total of around 340 volunteers participated in the cleanup, collecting driftwood and other refuse that had washed up on the beach. Around 180 Tonengeneral Group participants took part in the effort, including employees and their families from the Company’s Wakayama refinery and other locations, along with Tonengeneral Group dealers and their families from the Kansai area.

The Company has taken part in this initiative for around 40 years to help preserve the environment and natural beauty of Jinoshima.
