Shimizu Terminal's 77th Anniversary Commemorated with Performances of Children's Play

The Shimizu terminal (Shimizu-ku, Shizuoka City, Shizuoka; manager: Toshihiko Okamoto) of TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; representative: Jun Mutoh; "the Company" herein) presented a play performed by Theater Kazenoko, recipient of the 11th TonenGeneral Children's Culture Award in 1976, for students of nearby elementary schools and other local residents in a school gymnasium on June 22 and 24 as a commemorative event for the terminal's 77th anniversary.

Construction of the Shimizu terminal, originally a business and operations facility of the former Toa Nenryo Kogyo K.K., began with the establishment of that company in July 1939. In the 77 years since then, the facility has served as a research center, an oil refinery, and an oil terminal. The commemorative event was held to celebrate the terminal's 77th anniversary and to express gratitude to local residents. Around 1,300 guests, including students from Shimizu Sodeshi, Shimizu Tsuji and Shimizu Ejiri elementary schools, as well as members of local PTAs and community organizations, were invited to the event, during which the children's play "Youki no Hans" was performed a total of four times by Theater Kazenoko.

The vigorous movements of the cast members and the sounds made by various musical instruments and other objects captured the interest of the children in the audience, who were delighted with the performances.
