ENEOS Holdings, Inc. (President: Ota Katsuyuki) announces that it will be participating in "The Valuable 500", a global initiative to support the activities of people with disabilities with President, Katsuyuki Ota placing his signature on the participation form to validate our commitment.

The Valuable 500 is an initiative launched in January 2019 at the World Economic Forum Annual Meeting (commonly called "Davos Conference") to promote the active participation of people with disabilities. It was established based on the concept of "inclusive business creates an inclusive society", and its purpose is for business leaders

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to carry out reforms that enable people with disabilities to realize the potential value they bring to business, society, and the economy. As of November 20, 349 companies worldwide had expressed their support, making ENEOS the 26th company in Japan to do so.

ENEOS has established the following specific actions in support of this initiative.

- 1. Establish, maintain and improve targets for the employment rate of persons with disabilities as a priority issue.
- 2. Enhancing our support systems for the long-term stable employment of people with disabilities.
- 3. Working to further increase employee awareness of diversity and inclusion in order to create a workplace environment in which anyone, including those with disabilities can play an active role.

ENEOS is also implementing the following measures in relation to the inclusion of persons with disabilities.
