<u>Newly appointed Selection Committee member – Children's Culture Award</u> NAKAI Koji Professor, University of the Sacred Heart

Born in 1946. Graduated with a degree in philosophy from the Waseda University School of Literature I. Developed primarily educational and cultural programs for NHK. After serving as Managing Director for NHK affiliate NHK Educational, worked as a consultant for establishing educational TV in the Republic of Botswana. Has served as a judge at international competitions and as Secretary General for the Japan Prize International Contest for Educational Media. Became a full-time professor at University of the Sacred Heart in 2012.

<u>Newly appointed Selection Committee member – Japanese Traditional Music</u> TSUKAHARA Yasuko

Professor, Faculty of Music, Tokyo University of the Arts

Born in 1957. Completed a doctoral program at the Tokyo University of the Arts Graduate School of Music (PhD). Currently a professor in the Faculty of Music at Tokyo University of the Arts. Specializing in the history of Japanese music with an emphasis on the modern period, her published works include *Jûkyû Seiki no Nihon ni Okeru Seiyô Ongaku no Juyô* ('Reception of Western Music in Nineteenth Century Japan') and *Meiji Kokka to Gagaku* ('The Meiji State and Gagaku'). Her co-authored works include *Hajimete no Ongakushi* ('A Primer of Music History') and *Nihon no Dentô Geinô Kôza -Ongaku-* ('A Course in Japanese Traditional Arts – Music').
