Implementation of the Adopt Forest Nijozan TonenGeneral Goodwill Forest Maintenance Program

TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; president: Jun Mutoh; “TonenGeneral” herein) implemented its Adopt Forest Nijozan – TonenGeneral Goodwill Forest Maintenance program on October 31.

The objective of the program is the conservation of forests that the owners are no longer able to maintain. TonenGeneral has carried out this initiative in wooded areas along the Nijozan hiking trail in Yamada, Taishi-cho since 2011. In addition to cutting down surplus trees, program participants were educated about environmental matters, such as the benefits of forest thinning as a conservation effort (CO2 reduction, prevention of flooding and landslides, etc.). Forty-one volunteers, including service station dealers (volunteers from the Osaka-Hyogo Young Management Kai*), participated in the October 31 program.
