TonenGeneral Sekiyu Sakai Refinery Invites Newsletter Readers to Sakai City Opera Dress Rehearsal

TonenGeneral Sekiyu (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; president: Jun Mutoh) invited 50 readers of “Phoenix”, a newsletter issued by the company’s Sakai refinery, to a dress rehearsal of a regularly scheduled performance by the Sakai City Opera on August 31.

The Sakai City Opera has contributed to the cultural development of the local community through regularly scheduled performances and concerts since its founding as the Sakai City Community Opera Association in 1986. The group is also highly regarded overseas and in 2006 became the first Japanese opera troupe invited to participate in the world-renowned Puccini Festival in Italy, where it received great acclaim for its performance of “Madame Butterfly”.

Sakai Refinery has supported regularly scheduled performances by the Sakai City Opera since 1994 and in 2005 began inviting Phoenix readers to dress rehearsals held one day prior to actual performances. The dress rehearsals have been well-received and give attendees the opportunity to experience the artistry of opera firsthand. Invitees to this year’s dress rehearsal were treated to a world-class performance of “Chanchiki” (music: Ikuma Dan, script: Yoko Mizuki), a superb blending of Western opera and *kyogen*, a traditional Japanese theater form.
