### Implementation of the Adopt Forest Nijozan – TonenGeneral Goodwill Forest Maintenance Program

TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; president: Jun Mutoh; “TonenGeneral” herein) implemented its Adopt Forest Nijozan – TonenGeneral Goodwill Forest Maintenance program on May 10.

The objective of the program is the conservation of forests that the owners are no longer able to maintain. TonenGeneral has carried out this initiative in wooded areas along the Nijozan hiking trail in Yamada, Taishi-cho a total of five times, including trial implementations, since 2011. Participants in the May 10 effort, including 14 new employees from the company’s Sakai refinery as well as other TonenGeneral Group members and their spouses, numbered 41, the highest number ever for this program. In addition, the results of prior efforts in connection with the program were observed in the larger trunks and good branch growth of the trees remaining after previous thinning operations.
